

EXPLORING QUALITATIVE EVIDENCE SYNTHESES IN HARM REDUCTION SCOPING REVIEW OF THEIR METHODS AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR METHODOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENT

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AIM To describe the methodological characteristics of qualitative evidence synthesis conducted in the field of harm reduction and their opportunities for improvement.



METHODS Scoping Review

- · according to JBI guidance, based on a protocol.
- · search (PubMed June 2023): QES in the field of harm reduction.
- · two reviewers classified relevance according to harm reduction priorities.
- \cdot we extracted data on main characteristics and key methodological features.
- · we represented graphically the distribution of the studies (coloured points) according to their methodological appropriateness.
- · limitation searching in a single database might omit additional QES, but the sample is both comprehensive and representative.
