## Conflicts of interest can lead to misrepresentation of the evidence

## Because...

• Los Researchers may feel pressure to publish results favorable to their funders

• Experts may have personal or professional relationships that influence their opinions

• Companies or institutions with financial interests can spread claims that are biased in favor of their products

## **Warning signs**

"...the best product on the market..." "...no harmful effects..."

There is no declaration about conflicts of interest

The author or researcher is known to have a conflict of interest

- Be cautious if there is no information about how a study was funded
- Ask yourself if the source of information might benefit financially or otherwise from the claim
- Remember that research results are more reliable if the authors' conflicts of interest are stated
